Savane Carree High School Phase II and Final Completion

Thanks to the kind and merciful help of our great God, your prayers, and the generosity of FBC Geraldine AL, we have completed the high school facilities at Savane Carree.



These two pictures tell a story of answered prayer and God's grace. The picture on the left is of the pre-fab high school building components in storage in Thorsby AL on February 9, 2022. The picture on the right is of those same components going up in Savane Carree Haiti less than six weeks later on March 19. So much had to happen - shipping, finances, Haitian port and customs processes, navigating the political instability, and COVID testing - this can only be understood as a miracle of prayer and God's grace.



Bill & Sandy worked for months preparing things in Haiti. With some help from his best Haitian workers, Bill built the concrete forms for the slab. A team of two men (*one from FBC Geraldine AL and one from Davis Town Baptist in Section AL*) came and poured the concrete slab for the building. Then the very next week, a group of eight men from FBC Geraldine AL came in and erected the structure. Kerry Pope was crew foreman. The pictures below tell the story ...


