



GSM Schools are #1 in N. Haiti

Recently the Haitian government recognized GSM as having the highest pass rate and the highest grades on the standardized government exams that were recently administered in the Northern Province of Haiti. We do not know yet how we rank compared with the other provinces, but we think we may be #1 in the entire country. This is a great testimony to the determination and success of Bill & Sandy to maintain the highest standards of Christian education for our 1600+ children. And that is the best part - our children are learning in a Christian context of understanding.

- be in constant prayer for **Bill & Sandy** as they return to Haiti from their late summer break. They will be entering an extended time of service that will involve a tremendous amount and diversity of work, that will require discernment, wisdom, strength, patience, and courage.
- we will be breaking ground on Phase III of the **Shepherd's Care Medical Project** on October 3. This will launch us into an aggressive schedule of teams and construction that we pray will finish in June of 2015 with the completion of the medical dormitory/mission house. Bill and Sandy are having very fruitful discussions with a wonderful Christian doctors group with a view toward a good partnership that may launch our first medical services sooner than we thought.
- our fall **medical team** will be ministering to our children and workers Oct 28 - Nov 4
- our **Campus Life Week**, with emphasis on The Bible will be Oct 28 - Nov 4. We will be presenting hardback Bibles to all of our high school children.
- we have 2 teams that will be sharing “**The Hope of Christmas**” (*our Christmas bag ministry*) this year. Team I will minister Nov 25 - Dec 2. Team II will minister Dec 2 - 9.

GSM Annual Christmas Container

A big part of our annual Christmas ministry in Haiti is the loading and shipping of our Christmas container. We load it in Melbourne, FL, then it goes to Miami to be put on a ship bound for Haiti. 
These items are to help furnish the new medical dormitory/missionary home for the Shepherd's Care medical project at Savane Carree ...
