

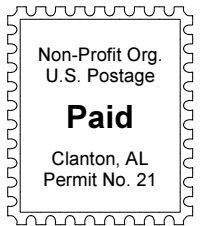

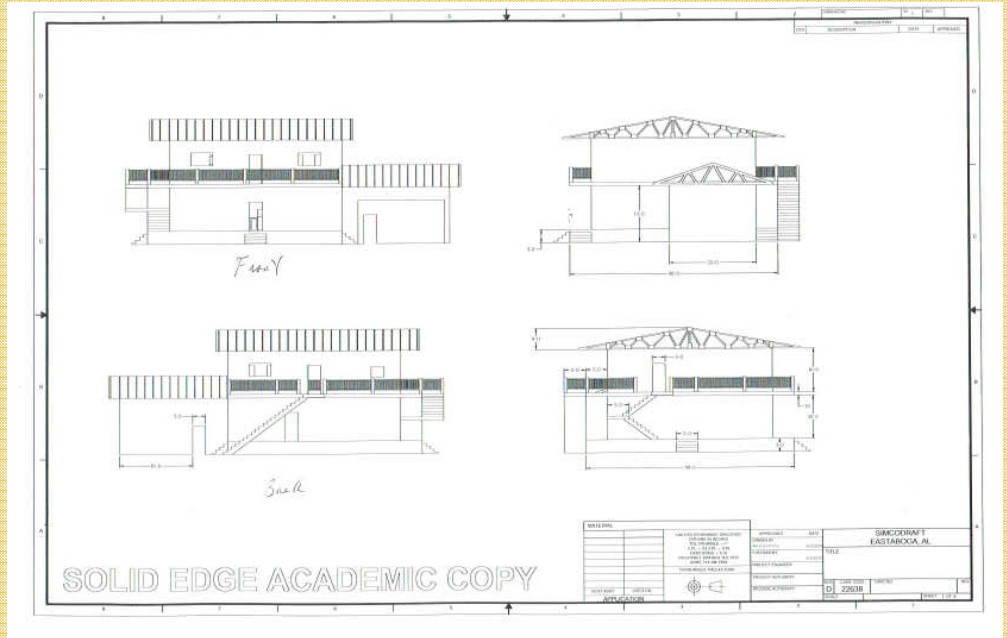
The Hope of Christmas
