Team Report


We are very grateful for all of the team work we have been blessed with over the past few months ...

Critical Need


complete set of batteries for our generator/inverter system

27 batteries - \$145 each - available in Cap Haitian

This system supplies 24 hr electricity to the mission house, high school, elementary school, and vocational school. Our batteries are all expiring. Normally we charge the batteries for a few hours, then run off of the batteries for the rest of the day and night. But because we are unable to store electricity, we are having to run lights, etc. right off of the generator. This is like using a semi-truck to bring home a sack of groceries. Our diesel fuel expense is very high because of this.

Also, we are in need of a new inverter and batteries to power Faith Hall, which houses our seminary, dorms, and offices.
