Over 2500 gifts have been shared in Christmas Gospel worship services. In addition, we shipped 175 fifty pound bags of rice on the container. Each of our Haitian works received a bag. Every Christmas gift bag had 1 to 3 pounds of rice and beans. And we shared 66 "Hope Buckets" provided by White Pond Baptist Church in Alabama. All said, well over 8 tons of direct food support was shared during "The Hope of Christmas". We are thankful.

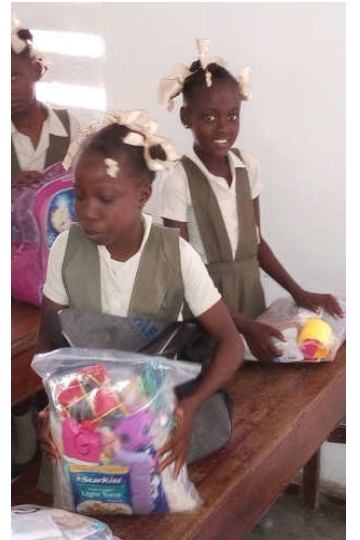

Bill & Sandy - Bill is just returning from some time in Haiti. Sandy did not go. But after her next immunotherapy treatment March 28, they will go back to Haiti together on April 4. They will be there for three weeks, at which time they will come back out for her next treatment. They will only be out long enough for her treatment, then they will go back in. That will remain the pattern for the foreseeable future.

The Situation in Haiti - the political situation remains unsettled and volatile. But the situation where we are in the north is not quite as difficult as it is in the south. But there is no light at the end of the tunnel concerning the resolution of the situation. No one knows how things will resolve.

The Ministry - miraculously and wonderfully, the work of GSM remains at 100% effectiveness. Our children are in school, our workers are working, things are going quite well, the medical clinic is open, and God, through His faithful people, is meeting every need.
