Rice Project

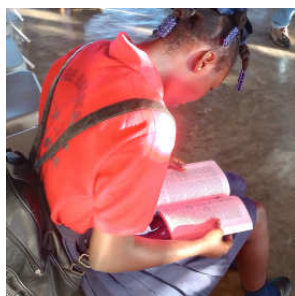

High School Bible Study at Savane Carree

One of the most exciting things that is happening right now at GSM is our High School Bible Study at Savane Carree. It is voluntary. The students come to school early, arriving at 7:00 am. They sing some songs and then read 1 chapter in the New Testament. After which Bill answers any questions they might have about what was read. They began with Matthew 1 and will work through the entire New Testament. Usually there are 40 - 50 students in attendance.



Meet Djouly Guerrier

Djouly is a 27 year old young man. He is married with 2 children and lives about 50 yards down the street from our Savane Carree school. When he was a child, he attended our school there. Today he works closely with Bill every day ... learning every aspect of maintaining the compound - electrical, generator, solar panel systems (*in the background*), water well systems, plumbing, vehicle maintenance, and carpentry. He is incredibly teachable, smart, and a fast learner. Toto has gone back to Milot to oversee maintenance there. Our hope is that Bill can turn the maintenance responsibilities of Savane Carree over to Djouly some day. ►
