- 1700+ students begin their school day with the songs of faith, Bible readings, and prayer during morning assembly.
- the high school students go deeper into God's Word in their daily Bible class.
- in addition, all of our students attend weekly chapel with songs and preaching.
- three proven men of God lead the spiritual thrust of our work: Maxie Michelle, Jean Claude Blaise, and Gourneau Norcejour. All three are alumni of our GSM schools.
- our medical clinic at Savane Carre is fully operational, continuing to minister to the needs of the people in that region.
- there are 160+ Haitians on staff at GSM. They work in a multitude of capacities from nurse to guard to groundskeeper to teacher to chaplain. Thanks to your support, GSM has never failed to make our monthly payroll in Haiti. Jobs are scarce in Haiti. And it may not be much, but what they do earn is of critical importance to our Haitian staff and their families.

Last Thursday (Nov 11) Bill & Christian were at Haitian customs working to complete the inspection of our Christmas container, and gain its release from the government. During that process Bill was surprised and deeply moved by the number of Haitians that greeted him, asking how he was doing. You see, many missionaries have left Haiti. Bill's familiar face and presence seemed to touch those Haitians. He has been there twenty-five years. His is a well-known face to the Haitian people.

The work of GSM in Haiti is the life work of Bill & Sandy. They remain 100% assured of God's call on their lives, and 100% committed to the work of GSM in Haiti. They hope you will continue in your confidence and support of the work of GSM.
