A Report on This Year's Christmas Ministry

The Hope of Christmas

The container and all the contents are now safely on our Milot compound. This is nothing short of a miracle given the political instability and unrest. Thank you for praying the gifts through to our compound. Here is how things happened ...

After many visits to officials in Cap Haitian, Bill determined that with God's help we could get the container through. So on November 15 we loaded the container in Thorsby, Alabama and it left for the trucking journey to Miami. On November 21 it was loaded onto the good ship Sara Regina and left Miami for the voyage to Cap Haitien by way of the Dominican Republic. After stopping in the DR the ship made port in Cap Haitien on November 29. By the next Friday, December 6, all the red tape had been cut, the bills and taxes paid, and the short trucking haul down to Milot accomplished without incident. All of the Christmas gifts are safely stored on our compound. We are thankful.

But at present, throughout the country, the children are still not in school due to the threat of violence. Our plan now is to pray that the children are able to be back in school by the time Bill & Sandy go back on January 16. At that time we hope to be able to share the gifts in proper fashion, with worship services and the preaching of the Christmas Story. So continue in prayer as we plan for the sharing of *The Hope of Christmas* next month. Bill & Sandy delayed their Christmas furlough for a week in order get the container through the process. They came home as soon as everything was secured.
